CHURCH GROUND CAR PARKING – PAY & DISPLAY

In order to assist with the maintenance costs of the Church and Grounds, we are introducing 'pay and display' car parking with effect from Monday 18th June 2018.

The charge rates are: €1 = one hour €3 = one full day

Please note the 'charge times' are 7.00am Monday to 17.00pm on Saturday

All Mass times are **excluded**. All Church events (funerals, baptisms, etc) are **excluded**

We are introducing 'BLUE' carpark allocated spots at the front, side and rear of the Church – these spots shall be reserved 100% for Church Visitors and they are **excluded** from the pay and display tariff at all times.

At present there are 11 parishes in the diocese using this system successfully.

We trust this will become a new 'income stream' for Kilmacud Church and assist with the upkeep costs of the Church without causing any inconvenience to all Church Visitors.
