A few words from Fr Joe.....

During the week I travelled to France to join in a celebration for a 60th birthday. Pauline came to stay in our home in 1980 as an exchange student, we became firm friends and have always stayed in touch, visited often and grown older as the years flew by. Her husband and three grown sons made this party as a surprise for her birthday and invited people from many different moments in her life, from school, college, work and life in general. It was such a joy to experience her friends and family making a fuss, providing everything for a woman who typically looks after everyone else. Friends really bless our lives.

I was glad of the chance to get away for a few days and to spend some time in prayer and reflection with the monastic community of Jerusalem at the church of St Gervaise. I don't have enough French to really understand what's being said, but I love the sound of their prayer and song, always gentle and deeply spiritual. This community is a real sign of renewal in the church, attracting many young men and women to commit to Christ, to a life of prayer and service, and they do it with great joy and love.

All through the week the voices of those who participated in the 'scoping' enquiry accompanied my thoughts and prayers. The residual suffering, years after abusive experiences in school, are so expressive of hurt betrayal and loss. Their courage to speak out now demands that their stories are heard and believed and that a generous and fulsome response is forthcoming from the religious orders. Local schools are mentioned in the report, my own former boarding school is there too, so it feels up close and personal. If there is anything that we can do at parish level to offer comfort and support please ask.
